

Asking someone to vote for you



Asking someone to vote for you is called a **proxy** vote

A proxy vote can be useful if you are away from home on election day or have a medical issue or disability



The person you choose to vote for you should be someone you trust



You will need to tell them who you want to vote for - this person **must** vote for the person or people you want to vote for



You can **apply for a proxy vote** by downloading and filling out the application form at

electoral commission - vote by proxy
