Each GP surgery has their own list



The LD register means doctors can make sure you get the right support when you visit their surgery or when you make an appointment



## Reasons to join the Learning Disability register



You will be given extra support from your GP surgery, including



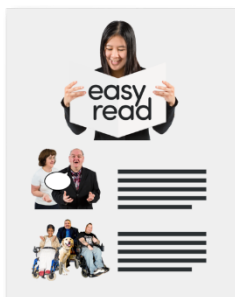
- help to make an appointment



- having a longer appointment



- having an appointment when the surgery is less busy



- information in easy read



- doctors using easier to understand English when they speak to you



- support to understand what your GP is saying



- more time to talk about how you are feeling



- a free annual health check every year – this can help you to stay healthy



- free flu and covid vaccines



## How to join the LD register



Contact your GP surgery



You may need to make an appointment to see a GP to talk about the LD register and if you can be added to it



## Check if you're already on the register



Contact your GP surgery to check if you are already on the LD register - if you are not on the LD register you can ask to be added to it
