
# Going to hospital for mental health treatment

for adults with learning disabilities





#### You are here because

you are under section (Mental Health Act 1983)



we are helping you to stay safe



we are helping you to get better



You will stay here for **up to 72 hours** (3 days)
This is called a **section 5(2)** or **emergency section** 



You will not be able to leave unless we say you can



# We can help you when you are feeling

sad



worried



frightened



confused



angry

## We can help you by



• listening to you



• talking with you



helping you to take your medication



giving you information



asking others to help you



helping you to stay safe

### You can



have visitors



make and receive phone calls



• send and receive emails and letters



• talk to us



• ask us for help



#### What happens next

You will stay here for up to 72 hours



We will give you support



We will give you medication if you need it



After 72 hours your team will meet with you



They will decide if you need to stay here for **longer** 



### If you want to leave hospital



 you cannot appeal against a section 5(2) – this means you cannot ask the hospital managers to let you leave the hospital



 you can ask a solicitor to help you – a solicitor is someone who knows about the law



this is a free service
